The Healing Touch

The health and safety of our students is always a top priority. That's why in years past we have closed school to prevent the spread of illness. With the growing concerns about the coronavirus be assured that we are closely monitoring the situation and news as it develops. Holy Angels follows the instructions of local/state health authorities and the Diocese of Rockford. This situation is very dynamic and evolving; therefore, we will continue to monitor all information as it arises.

I would like to share with you information that the Illinois Department of Public Health (IDPH) has published for schools throughout the state. Currently, the IDPH recommends that schools hold classes and events as usual and follow routine cleaning and disinfecting procedures. Surfaces across our school are cleaned daily and that practice will continue.

The IDPH also recommends the best way to protect against coronavirus is by taking the same everyday precautions against getting sick in general. They have asked all schools to implement lessons in hand washing and use of hand sanitizer. Additionally, they recommend:

- •Washing hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds
- •Avoiding touching eyes, nose, and mouth with unwashed hands
- Avoid close contact with people who are sick
- Staying home when sick
- •Cover cough and sneezes with a tissue, then throw the tissue in the trash
- •Clean and disinfect frequently touched objects and surfaces

We are increasing our efforts to educate and remind students of proper personal hygiene measures used to reduce the spread of germs and to increase opportunities for handwashing throughout the school day. Attached is a quick reference guide of common ailments to better help you to determine when your child should stay home or come to school. (Thank you to Mrs. Bikun's niece who is a nurse for providing this for us.) Unfortunately, staying home when your

child starts to feel better can be frustrating but is critical for everyone's well-being.

Students who do not feel well during the school day will be evaluated by the school nurse. If needed, the school nurse will contact you directly to pick up your child. Please be sure that your emergency contact list is current so that a sick child does not have to wait long before being picked up for that loving, healing touch that only a parent can provide.
