Time to Say Goodbye

Mr. Carlo LoSurdo will be leaving us at the end of the school year. We wish him well in the next chapter of this adventure we call life. Mr. LoSurdo currently teaches 6-8th grade religion which may leave many wondering how religion will be delivered in the upper grades. Next year, homeroom teachers as well as Mrs. Taylor and Mrs. Williams will be teaching religion. All classes will meet for the first period of the day for religious instruction. This change allows for us to both meet the Diocesan standard of 150 minutes of religion per week as well as offer time to devote to STEM instruction.

She'll be back on Fee Day to process tuition. Father Lavan agreed to this remote working position to allow us to transition smoothly into a new school year. Mrs. Cosenza's service to me and this school have been invaluable, and I know that I will miss her dearly.
