Baby Bottles

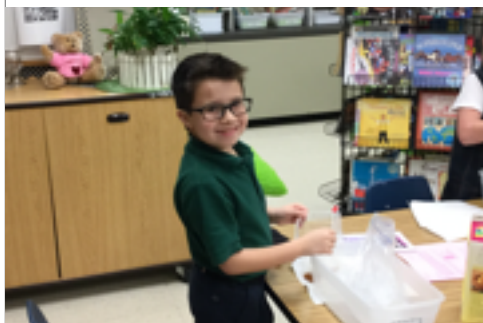
