Anatomy of a Broken Heart

Heart disease doesn't happen just to older adults. It is happening to younger adults more and more often. This is partly because the conditions that lead to heart disease are happening at younger ages. February is *Heart Month*, the perfect time for our 6th-8th graders to learn about their risk for heart disease and the steps they need to take now to help their heart.

For the past two weeks, as part of STEM classes, Mrs. Konovodoff, our school nurse, has been co-teaching with Mrs. Coughlin a basic anatomy of the circulatory system, how to be heart healthy, and how to potentially save a life using CPR. On Tuesday, February 4, the Parish Finance Council met to review proposed budgetary items for the 2020-2021 school year. Based on their guidance, tuition costs for the upcoming year will be:

1 child - \$4,450

2 children - \$6,910

3 children - \$9,050

4 children - \$10,460

5 children and more add \$200 for each additional child

Without a doubt, Catholic education is a sacrifice. In these times, it's not an easy decision to skip a meal out or drive the same car for a year or two longer to provide a quality Catholic education for your children.
